



2019 Bloomin' BBQ Cookoff Rules & Information

ENTRY FEE: \$75 for Another Bloomin' BBQ Cookoff;
\$25 for Friday night Wings Competition;

Another Bloomin' Festival vendor space/sales requires additional application and entry fee.

DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION: April 20th, 2019 – 7am

GENERAL INFORMATION-

Meat Inspection

- All meat must be in store packaging and will be inspected before BBQ competitors are allowed to prepare meat. Meat inspection will begin at 6:00pm on Friday, April 19th.

Set Up

- The Cookoff will be located in the downtown historic Candler County courthouse parking lot, which is located across from the downtown parks on Hwy 46. All spaces in the lot will be clearly marked and cleared by 6:00 PM Friday evening (April 19th, 2019). You are allowed to set up your tent/BBQ station any time between then and 7:00am, April 20, 2019. **ALL STATIONS MUST BE SET UP AND READY TO GO BY 9am!**

Clean Up

- All BBQ stations should begin cleanup when all categories are turned in. All stations must be cleared by 7:00pm.

Space Requirements

- Each team will be assigned a space in the court house parking area in which to set up your BBQ station. You may use tents, tables, and tailgate as long as it all fits into your space.
- Teams who need to use electricity for their tents must provide their own heavy duty extension cord at least 100 ft long.
- Large dumpsters will be provided for the BBQ area but each team must provide their own trash bags for cleanup.
- A water facility will be available for those who need it.

Chicken Wing Competition

- Wing Competition will take place Friday night before Another Bloomin' Festival
- Each team will be provided wings for grilling on-site at BBQ station
- Wings will be judged by local law enforcement officers
- Winner announced following competition and again at Another Bloomin' Festival

Sales Requirements

- Individual sales of BBQ will only be permitted to those teams with accepted and paid Another Bloomin' Festival vendor booth spaces.
- *Although teams selling BBQ will be required to pass a health inspection if asked, you will be expected to adhere to basic ServSafe sanitation/safe food handling practices. If food handling practices are considered detrimental by the organizers, those infractions must be corrected or your teams' sales will be cutoff.*

Agreement

I agree to help keep and maintain grounds, practicing all safety rules, particularly fire safety. If for any cause whatsoever it becomes impossible, including inclement weather, to have the cook-off, I understand this agreement is terminated and I will waive any and all claims for damages. "Another Bloomin' Festival", Metter-Candler Chamber of Commerce, City of Metter, or Candler County government will not be responsible for any injury or loss that may arise or come to the participant, or his employees, or his goods, from any cause whatsoever, while premises are being occupied under this agreement. "Another Bloomin' Festival" will provide no insurance; any insurance must be placed and paid for by the participant. I hereby relieve the management of the cook-off of all responsibility in connection with the safekeeping of the property while said properties are at this show.
